California Sports Hall of Fame partnership opportunities available

(ONTARIO, California, May 6, 2024) – Partnerships are available for the California Sports Hall of Fame, this year honoring five legends whose on- and off-the-field contributions have made an indelible impression on the state's sports landscape.

Partnership opportunities are available for both the Inductee Gala, June 30 at the Ontario Convention Center, and the Golf Classic, July 1 at Red Hill Country Club in Rancho Cucamonga.

This year's inductees are Lakers Iron Man **A.C. Green**, who holds a National Basketball Association record for most regular-season games played; San Diego State and Rams running back **Marshall Faulk**, the National Football League's Most Valuable Player in 2000; **Scott Boras**, who was named by Forbes magazine as the Most Powerful Sports Agent in the World; quarterback **Rodney Peete**, an All-America with the University of Southern California who played 15 years in the NFL; and **Andrew D. Bernstein**, who has served as the official sports photographer for most professional teams in Los Angeles and is the NBA's longest-tenured photographer.

Roy Firestone (Hall of Fame Class of 2022) will be the Master of Ceremonies for the Inductee Gala.

"The impact that these five sports industry legends have had cannot be measured in numbers alone. In so many different ways, they have enhanced and transformed the experience for fans and entire communities, and helped to make California the center of the American sports scene," said Christian Okoye, former All-Pro running back for the Kansas Chiefs and founder of the California Sports Hall of Fame.
